

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART 2 ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 214 GENERAL FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 214.08 FEES IN THE BUILDING & HOUSING CODE, PARAGRAPH (g) COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, ITEM (Y), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council wishes to allow businesses to utilize temporary banners and pennants to promote their businesses, and;

WHEREAS: Council has determined that thirty days maximum placement of the temporary banners and pennants is too restrictive and wishes to extend the time allowed for temporary placement; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend Section 214.08 to create permit fees for these temporary banners and pennants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part 2 Administration, Chapter 214 General Fee Schedule, Section 214.08 Fees in the Building & Housing Code, Paragraph (g) Commercial Buildings, Item (Y) is hereby amended to hereinafter read as follows:

214.08 Fees in the Building & Housing Code		
(g)	Commercial Buildings	
(Y)	Signs – with approval of Planning Commission	\$40.00 each
	Signs – Temporary w/approval of Planning Comm.	\$40.00 (One/30 days per year)
	Signs-Temporary Banners/Pennants	\$40.00 (each/120 days per year)

Section 2. Section 214.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provision of Chapter 214 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council has determined that it is immediately necessary to amend Section 214.08 to create permit fees for these temporary banners and pennants.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
