AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF AERO-MARK, INC. FOR THE 2005 STREET STRIPING PROGRAM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,940.00 AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The city has advertised for bids for street striping for 2005; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the bid of Aero-Mark, Inc. is the best bid for an amount not to exceed \$54,940.00; and

WHEREAS: Council wishes to accept this bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The bid of Aero-Mark, Inc. for street striping for 2005 for an amount not to exceed \$54,940.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Aero-Mark, Inc. in a form approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. The Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Aero-Mark, Inc.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of street striping services in 2005 for the City of North Royalton so that work can be commenced.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
