

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 05-171

AN ORDINANCE MAKING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE YEAR 2006 FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: There will be at the end of the year 2005 unencumbered balances and an anticipated sum of money sufficient to take care of current expenses and other expenditures in the funds of the City of North Royalton, Ohio; and

WHEREAS: Such amounts are/or will be available in any and all events for appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditure of the City within the first quarter of the year 2006, and the members of this Council now wish to appropriate such amounts as may be found necessary to meet the current expenses and other expenditures prior to April 1, 2006.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Royalton, Ohio, for the first quarter of the fiscal year 2006, the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated as itemized on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully written.

Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to draw warrants for the payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board of officers authorized by law to approve same, or in Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditures; however, that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries, or wages, except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinances.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the payment of salaries of officers, and employees, bills, claims, assessments and other obligations of North Royalton, Ohio, and a measure of necessary operations of all municipal departments.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
