A RESOLUTION URGING THE NEORS D TO COMPLETE THE NECESSARY STUDIES TO
EVALUATE THE VIABILITY OF A REGIONAL STORM WATER SYSTEM IN ORDER TO PROVIDE
RELIEF TO OVERBURDENED DRAINAGE SYSTEMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton and various other municipalities in the area have experienced
excessive storms resulting in basement and surface flooding on an increasing basis; and

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton recognizes that the intensity of many of the recent rains events is
far greater than the existing capacity of the existing storm drainage systems; and

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton recognizes that in order to improve the existing drainage systems
in our area it will require a cooperative effort of all communities in our region; and

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton is aware that the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District has been
studying the possibility of taking an active role in regional storm water drainage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON,
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton urges the NEORS D to complete the necessary studies to
evaluate the viability of a regional storm water system in order to provide relief to overburdened drainage
systems.

Section 2. The Director of Legislative Services is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to
NEORS D Director Odeal, all NEORS D Board Members, and all NEORS D communities.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this
Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in
compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council
has determined that it is immediately necessary to urge the NEORS D to complete the necessary studies to
evaluate the viability of a regional storm water system in order to provide relief to overburdened drainage
systems.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
