## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SMITH BROS., INC. FOR SAWDUST FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON COMPOST FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: In accordance with applicable law, the City of North Royalton has advertised for bids for sawdust for the North Royalton Compost Facility; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the bid of Smith Bros. Inc. for sawdust in the amount of \$6.94/cu. yd. for a period of one year is the lowest responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to accept this bid.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON,  
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The bid of Smith Bros., Inc. for sawdust for the North Royalton Compost Facility in the amount of \$6.94/ cu. yd. for a period of one year is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive and responsible bid as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Smith Bros., Inc. in a form approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. The Wastewater Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Smith Bros., Inc. and all certified checks and bonds are hereby authorized to be returned to the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of sawdust for the proper operation of the North Royalton Compost Facility.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
