AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 90-217, STAFFING AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, SECTION 7, POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council and the Administration have determined that it is necessary to create the position of I.T. Systems Administrator/LAN Manager, full time, in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance 90-217 to provide for this additional staffing; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 90-217, Staffing and Classification Plan, Section 7, Police Department, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

Section 7. Police Department

CLASSIFICATION (Job Title)

MAXIMUM NO. OF EMPLOYEES

19. I.T. Systems Administrator/LAN Manager

One (1)

Section 2. Ordinance No. 90-217 is amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Section 7 and Ordinance No. 90-217 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council has determined that it is immediately necessary to provide for the position of I.T. Systems Administrator/LAN Manager, full time, in the Police Department.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
