

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 08-35

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Stefanik

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH RICHARD L. BOWEN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., AS CONSULTING ENGINEER TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON AND TO APPROVE THE APPOINTMENT OF KENNETH A. TYRPAK AS CITY ENGINEER AND DANIEL J. COLLINS AS ASSISTANT CITY ENGINEER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The Mayor sought proposals from outside engineers and engineering organizations to provide consulting engineering services to the city including the appointment of a City Engineer and Assistant City Engineer; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor has selected the firm Richard L. Bowen and Associates, Inc., as Consulting Engineer, along with Kenneth A. Tyrpak as City Engineer and Daniel J. Collins as Assistant City Engineer; and

WHEREAS: Council authorizes the Mayor to execute various contracts and confirms various appointments made by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to keep an accurate record of these various appointments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter and execute a contract with Richard L. Bowen and Associates, Inc., naming said organization as the Consulting Engineer of the City for the purpose of providing consulting engineering services to the city in substantially the same terms and conditions as set forth in the contract which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and which is incorporated herein as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2. Council hereby approves of the Mayor's appointment of Kenneth A. Tyrpak as City Engineer and Daniel J. Collins as Assistant City Engineer, both of whom are members of the Richard L. Bowen and Associates, Inc., organization for providing engineering services to the City of North Royalton. Their compensation shall be the same as set forth in the contract shown as Exhibit A and attached hereto.

Section 3. Said appointments shall run concurrent with the Mayor's term of office or until such time as a successor has been appointed and confirmed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to keep accurate public records as to the various appointments made by the Mayor and the dates and terms of said appointments.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
