ORDINANCE NO. 08-41

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF
JOSEPH P. O'MALLEY TO SERVE AS SECOND ASSISTANT PROSECUTOR FOR THE
CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: The position of Second Assistant Prosecutor is an appointive position; and
- WHEREAS: The Mayor has appointed Joseph P. O'Malley to the position of Second Assistant Prosecutor; and
- WHEREAS: Council confirms the various appointments made by the Mayor; and
- WHEREAS: Council desires to confirm this appointment; and
- WHEREAS: It is necessary to keep an accurate record of these various appointments as to individuals appointed and their term of office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton hereby confirms the appointment of Joseph P. O'Malley as Second Assistant Prosecutor for the City of North Royalton, and hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor and the Director of Legislative Services to enter into a contract for Mr. O'Malley's professional services, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The term of said appointment shall run concurrent with the Mayor's term of office, or until such time as a successor has been appointed and confirmed.

Section 3. That the annual salary of said appointed official shall be as set forth in the contract, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the aforementioned appointment and ensure the effective operation of the Law Department.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
