AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 07-140 PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE YEAR 2008 FOR CURRENT
EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It has been determined to be necessary to amend Ordinance 07-140 providing for temporary appropriations for the first quarter of the year 2008 for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Royalton by making additional appropriations to the SCMR Fund; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 07-140 providing for temporary appropriations for the first quarter of the year 2008 for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended by making additional appropriations to the SCMR Fund as provided for in Exhibit A attached thereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council has determined that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 07-140 by making additional appropriations to the SCMR Fund.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
