AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART TWELVE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE, CHAPTER 1246 DESIGN STANDARDS, SECTION 1246.03 SCHEDULE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY PAVEMENT, CURB AND SIDEWALK DIMENSIONS AND TYPES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It has been recommended that Council amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part Twelve Planning and Zoning Code, Chapter 1246 Design Standards, Section 1246.03 Schedule of Right-of-Way Pavement, Curb and Sidewalk Dimensions and Types, by changing the sidewalk width on major arterial streets from 6 ft. to 5 ft.; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part Twelve Planning and Zoning Code, Chapter 1246 Design Standards, Section 1246.03 Schedule of Right-of-Way Pavement, Curb and Sidewalk Dimensions and Types is hereby amended to hereinafter read as follows:

1246.03 SCHEDULE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY PAVEMENT, CURB AND SIDEWALK DIMENSIONS AND TYPES.

Section 2. Section 1246.03 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Chapter 1246 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council has determined that it is immediately necessary to amend Section 1246.03 Schedule of Right-of-Way Pavement, Curb and Sidewalk Dimensions and Types by changing the sidewalk width on major arterial streets from 6 ft. to 5 ft.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
