ORDINANCE NO. 08-93

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPOSITION OF THE TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, CHAPTER 884, ENTERPRISE ZONE GUIDELINES, SECTION 884.12 TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Section 884.12 Tax Incentive Review Council, of Chapter 884, Enterprise Zone Guidelines, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton provides for the formation of a Tax Incentive Review Council in the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: Certain members of the Tax Incentive Review Council have been appointed by the North Royalton City Council, the Mayor and the Board of Education of the North Royalton City School District as provided for in Section 884.12; and

WHEREAS: The North Royalton City Council desires to provide for the composition of the membership of said Tax Incentive Review Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Tax Incentive Review Council of the City of North Royalton shall be composed of the following members in accordance with Section 884.12 of the Enterprise Zone Guidelines set forth in Chapter 884 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton:

- (1) Mayor Robert A. Stefanik;
- (2) Karen Fegan, Director of Finance;
- (3) Kevin M. Lynch (Mayoral appointment);
- (4) Stephen A. Ripepi (Mayoral appointment);
- (5) Vince Gentile (Council appointment);
- (6) Larry Antoskiewicz (Council appointment);
- (7) The County Auditor or his/her designee;
- (8) Board of Education appointment.

Section 2. The Tax Incentive Review Council shall carry out its duties in accordance with the Enterprise Zone Guidelines set forth in Chapter 884 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton.

Section 3. The terms of the members of the Tax Incentive Review Council shall be pursuant to Section 884.12 of the Enterprise Zone Guidelines.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that proper operation of the Enterprise Zone Program requires the immediate formation of the Tax Incentive Review Council.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
