

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 08-187

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CARGILL INC., SALT DIVISION, FOR ROAD SALT WITH AN OPTIONAL SECOND YEAR RENEWAL FOR THE 2008-2009 SEASON, AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton may purchase road salt through its membership in the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium at a lower rate than if it purchased it on the open market; and

WHEREAS: The bids submitted to the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium were consistent with the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and Charter of the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: Council wishes to accept the bid of Cargill Inc., Salt Division, for road salt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The bid of Cargill Inc., Salt Division, through the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium, for the supplying of salt for the Service Department of the City of North Royalton is hereby accepted as the primary source for road salt as follows: Untreated Salt for \$41.06 per ton dump truck (delivered) and the optional second year renewal at a cost of \$47.21 per ton dump truck (delivered), and Treated Salt (Clearlane) for \$53.38 per ton dump truck (delivered) and the optional second year renewal at a cost of \$59.53 per ton dump truck (delivered), with a minimum order of 25 tons in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Service Director, with a 24 hour delivery guarantee, as further set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of North Royalton with Cargill Inc., Salt Division, as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3. The Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Cargill Inc., Salt Division.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of bulk road salt for the City of North Royalton.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
