A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE NORTH ROYALTON HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND FOR RECEIVING A SUPERIOR RATING AT THE 2008 OHIO MUSIC EDUCATION ASSOCIATION COMPETITION

WHEREAS: The North Royalton High School Marching Band began competing at the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) Competition in 1986; and

WHEREAS: In those 22 appearances, they have earned 18 consecutive Superior 1 Ratings; and

WHEREAS: 2008 marks the 20th year that the North Royalton Marching Band has been awarded the rating of Superior 1; and

WHEREAS: A Superior 1 Rating is described as an outstanding performance with very few technical errors and exemplifying a truly musical expression, and this rating is reserved for the truly outstanding performance; and

WHEREAS: The competitors in the OMEA Competition are judged on their music, general effect, visual performance, visual effect, percussion, and other special unit aspects such as auxiliary and field commanders, and soloists; and

WHEREAS: Mayor Stefanik and the Council of the City of North Royalton wish to commend the North Royalton High School Marching Band for its dedication to excellence and for making their community proud.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:
