ORDINANCE NO. 08-225

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF A MORAL CLAIM TO STANLEY AND KIMBERLY ROBINSON OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,593.48, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Stanley and Kimberly Robinson of the City of North Royalton incurred monetary expenses as a result of flooding in their home at 12900 Edgerton Road; and

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton does not have a legal obligation but may have a moral obligation to reimburse Mr. and Mrs. Robinson for a portion of these expenses; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to reimburse Mr. and Mrs. Robinson for an amount not to exceed \$2,593.48 to cover the cost of cleanup expenses incurred by the Robinsons as a result of this flooding event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the payment of a moral claim to Stanley and Kimberly Robinson for an amount not to exceed \$2,593.48 to cover the cost of cleanup expenses, contingent upon the execution of a release of all claims against the City of North Royalton in a form approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to provide for payment of this moral claim.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for this reimbursement.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
