## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EMERGENCY OPERATING LEVY OF THE NORTH ROYALTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS: The North Royalton City School District has a tradition of excellence in educating the children of the city; and

WHEREAS: A quality school district is essential to the quality of life and making the city a desirable place to live and raise a family; and

WHEREAS: The North Royalton City School District has a 6.2 mill ten (10) year emergency operating levy before the voters of the District on the May 5, 2009, special election; and

WHEREAS: This emergency operating levy will provide \$6.7 million per year for the operations of the District; and

WHEREAS: The passage of this emergency operating levy is essential for the maintenance of the current educational programs for the students of the District; and

WHEREAS: The Council and Mayor Robert A. Stefanik support the 6.2 mill emergency operating levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton and Mayor Robert A. Stefanik hereby declare their support for the North Royalton City School District's 6.2 mill emergency operating levy and encourages all residents of the City of North Royalton to vote "Yes" on May 5, 2009, to maintain the current educational programs for the students of the school district.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of a majority of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
