AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 892 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Chapter 892 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton provides for a tax to be levied upon certain defined individuals attending specific forms of entertainment venues; and

WHEREAS: The Council deems it advisable to repeal Chapter 892, effective September 1, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Chapter 892 Admissions Tax of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby repealed, effective September 1, 2009.

Section 2. Part 8 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Part 8 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. All taxes/fees and/or registrations due and owing through August 31, 2009 shall be collected and processed as set forth in Chapter 892.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to repeal Chapter 892.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
