AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART 2 ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 220 COUNCIL, SECTION 220.06 RULES OF COUNCIL, RULE VII COMMITTEES BY CREATING A NEW PARAGRAPH (k) ENTITLED COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has determined the need to create a new committee entitled Committee of the Whole in order to address various items that are presented to Council; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part 2 Administration, Chapter 220 Council, Section 220.06 Rules of Council, Rule VII Committees, by creating a new Paragraph (k) entitled Committee of the Whole; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part 2 Administration, Chapter 220 Council, Section 220.06 Rules of Council, Rule VII Committees, by creating a new Paragraph (k) entitled Committee of the Whole, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

## RULE VII-COMMITTEES.

(k) Committee of the Whole.

There is hereby established a Committee of the Whole. The Committee of the Whole shall be comprised of all members of Council, with the President of Council to serve as Chairman and the President of Council Pro-Tem to serve as Vice Chairman. Committee of the Whole meetings shall be scheduled by the chairman on an as needed basis as determined by the chairman. Any topic which falls under the jurisdiction of the City Council shall qualify as a topic to be discussed in the Committee of the Whole if deemed necessary by the chairman. The Committee of the Whole shall serve only as a recommending body to City Council with no authority to adopt policy or legislation.

Section 2. All subsequent paragraphs in Rule VII shall be renumbered accordingly.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that Council has determined that it is immediately necessary to create a new committee entitled Committee of the Whole in order to address various items that are presented to Council.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
