## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER CUYAHOGA COUNTY'S COMPETITIVE MUNICIPAL GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS:** On behalf of the Cuyahoga County Board of Commissioners, the Cuyahoga County Department of Development administers Community Development Block Grant Funds provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
- WHEREAS:** The City of North Royalton desires a health and wellness facility to be located within the community; and
- WHEREAS:** The Greater Cleveland YMCA has entered into an agreement to provide health, wellness and fitness services out of a facility to be redeveloped and owned by the City at 11409 State Road; and
- WHEREAS:** Residents of the City of North Royalton would greatly benefit from improved access to a health and wellness facility, the positive impact that such an amenity has on commercial and residential property values in the community, and the redevelopment of a blighted foreclosed property; and
- WHEREAS:** Council wishes to authorize the Mayor to execute and file an application for Community Development Block Grant funding with the Cuyahoga County Board of Commissioners, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application for Community Development Block Grant funding with the Cuyahoga County Board of Commissioners, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 2. The City of North Royalton does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Community Development Block Grant Program and the Cuyahoga County Municipal Grant Program.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to adopt this legislation because local legislative approval to apply for these funds must be received by the Cuyahoga County Department of Development no later than November 4, 2010.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
