AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AGREEMENT WITH BRANDSTETTER CARROLL, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON YMCA PROJECT IN THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON FOR AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 TO COVER THE COST OF A DESIGN ALTERNATE FOR AN ELEVATED WALKING TRACK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council adopted Ordinance 10-102 to enter into an agreement with Brandstetter Carroll, Inc. in the amount of \$330,000 for professional design services for the North Royalton YMCA project; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to amend this agreement by approving an additional amount not to exceed \$25,000 to cover the cost of a design alternate for an elevated walking track.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends the agreement with Brandstetter Carroll, Inc. for professional design services for the North Royalton YMCA project in the City of North Royalton for an additional amount not to exceed \$25,000 to cover the cost of a design alternate for an elevated walking track.

Section 2. Funds in the amount of \$25,000 have been appropriated for this amendment.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend the agreement with Brandstetter Carroll, Inc. by approving an additional amount not to exceed \$25,000 to cover the cost of a design alternate for an elevated walking track.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
