MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Luks reported that Governor Taft signed the budget last week and the proposed local government fund cuts were restored, so we will not be facing the cuts that were included in the house's version of the budget.

Mayor Luks said that the Citizens Oversight Flooding Committee has completed and released their final report. The report contains an executive summary, prioritizes flooding related concerns, gives long and short term solutions and costs, outlines funding mechanisms and public outreach strategies are discussed. The Mayor read through some of the proposed recommendations. A copy of this report is available on the city's website. She said that the city will continue to find ways to move forward on these recommendations and will continue to apply for funding assistance and will look at other ways within our own financial means that we can plan for and fund these projects. Mayor Luks said we had a rather significant rain event last week and we fared very well. She said that she was pleased to see that some of the work we have done has paid off. Also attributable to how well we did was the fact that it has been such a dry year, so the creeks and rivers were not filled with water as was the case last year.

Mrs. Uffman-Kirsch said that she has been advised by the Ward Councilwoman that the majority of the effected residents are opposed to the installation of these sewers. She also asked if they were made aware of the need to replace their failing septic systems and the cost associated with both options and was assured that the residents were aware of this. Mrs. Uffman-Kirsch said that if the majority of the residents oppose this, she cannot support this Resolution.

Mrs. Uffman-Kirsch said that this Ordinance recommends amendments to recently passed legislation that requires anyone that is plowing snow in the city to register and pay a registration fee, to display a tag and an orange flashing light in the truck. These amendments would make these requirements applicable only to fee-based snow removal companies, and not private plowers who are doing their own driveways, their neighbor's driveway, or their friend's driveway for free. She said that she knows that the original intent of this legislation was to make sure we had a procedure in place by which plowers would know the city's rules and regulations on plowing. However she feels we can accomplish this goal through notification in the newspaper, the same way we would have to notify everyone that they would need to register. She does not think that the original legislation is an efficient means to reach the goal of resident education. She feels that it discourages community spirit of neighbors helping neighbors and with a penalty for non-registration being a misdemeanor, she feels that it is an example of government being too invasive. She asked Council to support this legislation.

Miss Zaccardelli said that she agrees with Mrs. Uffman-Kirsch.

Mr. Willey said that he still opposes this legislation and feels that it will be very difficult to enforce. When there is a lot of snow and people are plowing, the Police Department will be out doing other things of an emergency nature. He feels that it is a nuisance Ordinance and will vote against it.
