

ISSUE 1 MINUTES
July 1, 2008

The Issue 1 Committee meeting was held on July 1, 2008, at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Kasaris, seconded by Mr. Antoskiewicz to approve the June 3, 2008, minutes. Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Discussion of 2008 projects

Mr. Schmitzer provided the breakdown for the Akins Road and Bennett Road projects.

Mr. Schmitzer stated that it is his opinion that Bennett Hill is going to be the recommended project due to it being a major thoroughfare, the number of accidents reported on Bennett Road, and pavement concerns. The life span of the road is estimated to be 15-20 years with a single pass process with a depth of 6-8 inches.

The last time Bennett Road was resurfaced was in 1996 with a 3 inch grind process and overlay which only lasted approximately 10 years.

Mr. Willey asked about the storm sewer issue relative to the Bennett Road project. There was discussion of the option of using Issue 1 funding for the pavement and possibly storm sewer repairs in-house. Mr. Schmitzer suggested that including storm sewer repairs would increase our chances of receiving Issue 1 funding.

Moved by Mr. Kasaris and seconded by Mr. Antoskiewicz to recommend approval to Council authorizing the Mayor to apply for the Bennett Road Hill project repaving and storm sewers and the Akins Road reconstruction of pavement from Edgerton Road to York Road. Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Mr. Willey asked if the road width would change. Mr. Schmitzer said there would be some additional width increase. A question was posed regarding adding sidewalks.

Moved by Mr. Kasaris and seconded by Mr. Gentile to adjourn the meeting. Yes: 3. Nays: 0. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
