

## STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES

May 13, 2008

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on May 13, 2008, at North Royalton City Hall 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Moved by Mr. Gentile, seconded by Mr. Nickell to **approve the minutes of April 9, 2008**. Yeas: 3. Nays: 0.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

**1. North Royalton FEMA mitigation**

Mayor Stefanik said the asbestos removal should be completed in two weeks and then the homes should be removed.

**2. Storm water retention basin report**

Mr. Schmitzer said that all 132 storm water basins have been inspected. The report is being finalized and letters are being sent to homeowners associations if there are violations. He will provide a report on the status of repairs required from last year.

**3. Citizens Flooding Committee Report addendum**

No report.

**4. Turnpike run-off study**

A meeting was held last week with the Turnpike representatives. A meeting is to be scheduled with the Metro Parks.

**5. 2008 Projects**

Mayor Stefanik said the Edgerton Road storm sewer project is in the budget for this year. It is hoped that it will be coordinated with the county project.

Bids will be opened on May 22, 2008, for the Pamela/Parkdale Drives project. A timeline will be provided as soon as possible.

Maple Lane improvements will be sent out for bids on May 16, 2008, and opened on June 9, 2008.

Chesapeake retention basin will be bid soon.

Gregory will be bid soon. Mayor Stefanik said that the last easement was recently obtained.

**6. Edgerton Road 5244/5250**

Mayor Stefanik said NEORSD gave a presentation regarding a general overview of what will be done with the storm water utility in the future. This is one of the areas that they hope to include in their regional storm water component. This will not be something that will happen soon and our city will proceed as we need to resolve current issues. This is a project that is intended to deal with storm water drainage in a regional manner.

Mayor Stefanik said we are still waiting on the houses on Edgerton Road.

**7. Need for ditching on State Road from Wallings Road north**

Mr. Gentile said that the ditching has been deteriorating and that the Service Director needs the Engineering Department to determine grades so ditching can be done. Mr. Gentile will provide Mayor Stefanik with the specific request to include addresses.

**8. Chippewa Creek Study**

Mr. Antoskiewicz said a draft resolution was distributed to Council earlier for all the cities involved in the Chippewa Creek watershed area to show the communities are in agreement to move forward.

Moved by Mr. Gentile, seconded by Mr. Nickell to **recommend approval of this resolution** to Council. Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

Mr. Antoskiewicz said the next step after approval of the resolution would be the partnership agreement that was distributed to Council earlier. This will need to be approved by the cities in the future.

**NEW BUSINESS****1. Culverts**

Mr. Nickell said he is getting calls from residents on Sprague and Albion Roads regarding culverts and wanted to know what our responsibility is.

Mayor Stefanik said that our Service Director has met with the Service Director from Parma about Sprague Road between York and West 130<sup>th</sup>. It looks like we will have a joint temporary project this year to shore up the street, repair some of the berms. Culverts will be included with the temporary fix until the joint project with the county begins. It is anticipated that this will begin in the next three years. In the mean time we must do some repair.
