

STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES
November 8, 2007

The Streets Committee meeting was held on November 8, 2007, at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:36 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Proposed Ordinance 07-136 Huntington Park Subdivision, Phases 1 And 2 Dedication

Mr. Ramm said the Engineering Department performed the final inspection. Mr. Merdes issued a finalized report today and Mr. Zillich said he received it. There are a few items that can be handled quickly. The developer's agreements have been submitted and are being reviewed. Mr. Ramm suggested this remain in committee and can be removed at the next Council meeting if all is ready.

Mr. Willey said this is still in the Planning Commission since they meet before the next Council meeting they can make their recommendation to Council in time for the November 20, 2007 meeting.

Mr. Zillich said depending on the weather he is hopeful to get the items completed in time for the November 20, 2007, Council meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Recycling program-rubbish co-mingling

2. Automated rubbish system/privatization of trash collection

3. Road work 2007

Mr. Mayer said concrete work is completed for the 2007 season with the completion of the last section today. All crack sealing should be finished in about a week. Hot patching will continue as weather permits.

4. Wallings Road rehabilitation

Mr. Ramm said this should be completed soon. Mr. Gentile would like to see copies of all change orders.

5. Pasek property

6. Drake Road reconstruction

Mr. Ramm reported that the final walk-through was conducted today and the minor items will be completed in the next couple of weeks.

7. Edgerton Road reconstruction

Mr. Ramm explained that the final drainage work should be completed this week; paving, striping and driveways should be completed next week. The remainder will be completed in the spring.

8. Proposed Ordinance 07-73 dedication of Mahican Way, Shawnee Circle, and Chippewa Path in Indian Trails Subdivision

No action.

9. Chippewa Creek watershed study

Mr. Gentile said he will try to contact Mr. White next week because the 6-month moratorium window is coming soon and information was expected before the end of this year.

10. 2007/2008 FEMA catch basin projects

The project is completed and paperwork has been submitted to Mr. Kosdrosky who will send this to FEMA.

11. Proposed Ordinance 07-10 Greenways Plan

No action, waiting on information from Mr. O'Donnell.

12. Accepting construction materials at service yard

Mr. Mayer provided a spreadsheet with quotes from other companies explaining how residents would be charged. He was asked to estimate the number of containers that would be used each week. There was discussion on how to include residents who work during the week would be able to pay and drop off their material so that the employees working at the yard do not have to manage money and other issues.

2. Salt brine

Mr. Mayer said he would like to get salt brine quotes in an attempt to save the city money.
