

STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES

July 7, 2008

The Streets Committee meeting was held on July 7, 2008, at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Recycling program-rubbish co-mingling

Mr. Kamps told the committee that the new rubbish trucks were ordered and they should arrive in 90 days.

2. Road work 2008

All concrete work on Oak Knoll Court and Rustic Drive is complete. There was some slab work repair due to the heat buckling the pavement. Lynn Drive will be paved July 8th. Patching on hold for Patricia Drive, Gardenside Drive and Valley Lane due to rising fuel costs. Sprague Road's bid will go out on July 21st. Cost of fuel is affecting projects, rising 20 to 25%.

3. Wallings Road rehabilitation - No report or update.

4. Edgerton Road reconstruction - No report or update.

5. Proposed Ordinance 07-73 dedication of Mahican Way, Shawnee Circle, and Chippewa Path in Indian Trails Subdivision - No report.

6. Salt brine

Mr. Kamps said we should have no problem getting enough brine. He said we are hopeful we can use it this winter. One of the trucks we will be using is already brine equipped; the other two will be retro-fit with the correct equipment.

Mr. Nickell asked if we will have enough storage for salt this year. Mr. Kamps said it would be nice to store more than we might need but we don't have the space. Mr. Gentile said if we have the brine availability, it would cut down on our need for salt.

7. North Royalton N-STEP (Neighborhood Sidewalk Travel Expansion Program)

Mr. Nickell said he would like to see sidewalks or road extensions included on new road projects so residents can walk or ride their bikes. He stated with the gas prices as they are now, more people will be walking, riding bikes, or riding scooters. He also mentioned that Sprague Road should have at least one side of the road equipped with sidewalks due to the amount of traffic on that road.
