City receives \$430,000 Grant for Police Radios

Mayor Robert Stefanik is pleased to announce that the City of North Royalton Police Department is the recipient of a grant of all new, state-of-the-art Motorola radios valued at \$430,000. "North Royalton Safety Director Bruce Campbell worked for many months on this grant and has saved our citizens a great deal of tax dollars that we were otherwise required to spend to meet the new minimum standards imposed by the Federal Government."

Safety Director Campbell worked with the Cuyahoga County Communications Committee to secure the new radios, 26 mobile radios for all the police vehicles and 60 portable radios for use by the officers on their persons. The City of North Royalton will now meet all the new federal standards with the acquisition and installation of the new communication equipment.

"Grants of this magnitude are always welcome but even more so now as we continue to meet budgetary limitations by curbing spending, living within our means and searching out funding from every available source. This is but one example of the conservative and measured approach we are taking to respond to the financial downturn and avoid dramatic moves that would jeopardize the services our residents depend upon in their daily lives", said Mayor Stefanik.
