The 2010 Elections are quickly approaching, and the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections is kicking-off recruitment efforts for Election Day poll workers. The Board would like to continue to build a strong Election Day workforce at the polls and we need your help to do that.

Qualified individuals must be registered voters in Cuyahoga County and successfully complete a mandatory training session offered by the Board of Elections. An assessment is administered to each trainee at the conclusion of the session in order to evaluate the trainee's comprehension of the election functions on Election Day.

All Election Day workers must attend an organizational meeting on Monday night prior to the election. The meeting will begin at 6:00 PM, and be held simultaneously at each of the polling locations throughout Cuyahoga County. At this meeting, processes and procedures will be reviewed, and Election Day assignments will be designated by the Presiding Judge.

On Election Day, all poll workers are required to report to his or her polling location at 5:30 AM, and remain until all election tasks are completed after the polls close at 7:30 PM. Compensation will only be given to those who adhere to the training and attendance requirements stated above. The rate of pay is as follows: Presiding Judge, \$182.10, Judge \$172.10, and Polling Location Coordinator \$200.00.
