CLUBS:

Men's Softball: Mike Piscitello: Softball will not need York 3. Mike asks that NR High School give him 2 days notice, if they need to use the field at Memorial Park. Softball will start around April 24th. 7 – Mon/Wed teams, 12 - 35 & Over teams and 7 – 50 & over teams (Friday nights)

Baseball: Terry Veverka and Larry Bataglia: \$1500 was made at bake sale. Lot's of positive feedback about having signups at City Hall – things went very smooth. 1380 kids registered. A survey was given out – will share results when tallied. The boys HS league was up 30 kids – may have 12 teams. Girl's softball (Fast & Slow pitch) signups were down a little from last year. Signups were up for all other groups. New doors were installed on batting cages at York.

Soccer: Frank Castrovillari: Signups are a little lower this year. Fields are ready to go for 3/28 start. Soccer and Baseball are getting defibrillators. Ed has been given 2009 Budget and checks for \$10/child. Pictures went well over a 2 day period due to space constraints. They are still short on referees for the year. The woman's football league wants 2 travel NR soccer teams to play at halftime for one of their games at Byer's Field.

Basketball: Not present.

Recreation Director: Golf classes will start on 3/25/09 – 19 adults and 12 kids. Roofs installed on dugouts at York. Working on lights new York fields, wiring in the ground, will start holes soon. Engineering is finalizing plans for new parking lot at York. They expect to go out for bids soon.

School Board Representative: Heidi Dolezal: Some of NR Swimmers went to State as well as 2 NR coaches.

Mayor Stefanik: Getting new park ready for grand opening on May 9th. YMCA Adventure Guides will show people around.
