Meeting called to order by Chris at 6:02p.m.

Motion made by Chris R. to accept minutes from March 24th, 2009 meeting, Todd 2nd motion

CLUBS:

Men's Softball: Games started the week of 4/26.

Baseball: Terry Ververka and Larry Battaglia: Girls baseball signups down. NRBB received many complaints about team/coach/player choices not being honored. They plan to do a letter next year outlining the policy, which will probably be a draft with 3 picks.

Soccer: Frank Castrovillari: They purchased 2 defibrillators (one on behalf of baseball). Fire department will train coaches on the use of the defibrillators. The defibrillator will be kept at the concession stand. Only 1 game cancellation so far, season going well.

Basketball: Bob Baran – summer intramurals: He would like Recreation Department to install electrical outlets near the basketball courts for the scoreboards. He asked Recreation Board to approve the basketball flyer. Todd A. made motion to approve the flyer, Chris R. 2nd - motion carried.

Football: Mike Donnellan – Southern Hills Youth Football: They are in the middle of registration for fall season. He asked to use Valley Vista field, Ed said it was up to the schools. They will create a youth 7-8 grade league if the NR Levy fails, so the kids can keep up the skills – any money collected will be donated back to High School. They will need to use either city or NR school fields for games.

John Gordon – Boy Scout: He wants to make recycle bins for Memorial Park (and maybe other areas). Todd made motion to accept the recycle bins pending design approval by Recreation Department – Chris 2nd – motion carried.

Norm Pawlowski – Men's senior softball: They want to use York 3 on Wednesdays and/or Fridays from 10-11am. Chris made a motion to allow them to use York 3 on Mon/Wed 10-11am, Larry 2nd – motion carried.

Recreation Director: Ed Swim: The Abundant Life Church wanted to use Soccer fields for a Free Soccer Camp – they were turned down because of the field maintenance that would be required. But they will be having Free basketball and cheerleading camps on 6/22 – 6/26 and want to use City facilities. Chris R. made a motion to allow them to use city facilities for Basketball and Cheerleading camps, Larry A. 2nd motion – motion carried.
Dugouts are done and poles are cemented for new fields at York. They will be replacing a broken gate at York. The parking lot will be going out to bid soon.

Council Representative: Larry Antoskiewicz: They are soliciting bids for York Phase III (parking lot).

Oakridge Estates Swim Club would like the city to fill their pool toward the end of May. Chris made a motion for NFRD to fill the Oakridge Pool, Heidi 2nd – motion carried with Todd Althouse abstaining.

School Board Representative: Heidi Dolezal: Many improvements and repairs to the fencing around Football, Discus and soccer fields at the high school.

Mayor Stefanik: Not Present.
