RECYCLING SCHEDULE AND INFORMATION

Thank you for your continued support and participation in our recycling programs. The importance of these programs continues to grow as rubbish disposal costs rise, and all solid waste is disposed at area transfer stations.

Recycle items have greatly expanded and items may now be co-mingled, curbside pickup is weekly and should be placed in either **blue recycle bags** or **blue recycle bins** only (no larger than 18 gals).

Recycle station sorters have been placed at the following sites:

- **HEASLEY FIELD – 5100 Wallings Rd**
- **MEMORIAL PARK – 14600 State Rd**
- **NR SERVICE CENTER – 11545 Royalton Rd**

This recycling brochure is provided so that everyone can participate in the many service programs provided. Please take the time to read and review the recycling guidelines. The map inside this brochure will locate your pick up day, including the schedule for affected holidays. Also included in the guidelines, is information concerning the collection of yard waste and white goods.

RECYCLE Schedule & Map

Recycles are collected every week on your regular rubbish day. All materials must be out by 7:00AM on your collection day, but not before sunset of the evening before your collection day. Place recycle and/or yard waste containers on the opposite side of your drive from rubbish containers.

DROP-OFF GUIDELINES

- Plastic** All sizes of beverage, milk, water, juice, detergent and bleach bottles with caps & rings, pipe and fencing. **Rinse and flatten all bottles.** To include all recycle items marked #1 - #7, please refer to **Table of Resin Codes** within this brochure or the city website at www.northroyalton.org.
- Glass** All bottles and jars with caps & rings, **rinse all items.** **NO** windows, windshields, headlights, pyrex dishes, glassware, ceramic materials, mirrors or plate glass will be accepted.
- Aluminum & Metal Cans** Aluminum, tin, bi-metal cans, aluminum foil, pie/frozen dinner pans. Rinsed and flattened.
- Mixed Paper** Combination of newspapers, catalogs, magazines, junk-mail, all cardboard (cut to 1'x2' size), office-computer-school paper and phone books.
- Automobile Tires** Automobile, passenger, light truck tires **ONLY!** **Tire and rim must be separated!** Limit 4 tires per vehicle per year. No commercial or industrial tires.
- Auto Batteries** Undamaged automobile batteries **ONLY.** No other types accepted.
- Motor Oil** Place in environmentally safe containers with a tight lid to prevent spillage.
- Anti-Freeze** Place in environmentally safe containers with a tight lid to prevent spillage.
- Scrap Metal Household Appliances** Any metal items may be dropped off. Fuel and oil must be drained from gas powered items. No propane or fuel tanks will be accepted.
- Computers** All associated items including: keyboard, monitor, mouse, tower, scanner, fax, printer and cables. Also to include cell phones.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Curbside Collection and Compost Facility Information

YARD WASTE COLLECTION SEASON: From April 2, 2012 until December 8, 2012

GUIDELINES

For collection, materials such as grass clippings, flowers or leaves must be placed in a standard 32 gallon rubbish can or the large **paper** yard waste bags. These are the only acceptable containers for collection. Please **DO NOT USE** plastic bags, paper bags containing plastic liners or cardboard boxes during the collection season for yard waste. **DO NOT MIX** yard waste with dirt, rocks or sod. These items are not acceptable at the compost facility.

The collection of yard waste is every week on the same day as regular rubbish collection. Yard waste, like rubbish or recycling materials, must be out for collection day no later than 7:00AM but not earlier than sunset of the evening before a collection day. (N.R. Ord. 1060.01)

All branches must be cut to four-foot lengths and tied in bundles with cotton cord or twine. **NO** vinyl or wire will be accepted. All bundles must be tied securely so as not to break when lifted. Logs or limbs over 8 inches in diameter cannot be collected.

Residents are requested to separate yard waste containers from rubbish containers by placing them on the opposite side of the drive from rubbish and/or marking containers as "Yard Waste".

All containers and bundles for the above items are not to exceed 60 pounds in weight. If there are any questions regarding curbside collection services, call 440-582-3002.

Residents having yard waste and wishing to drop it off at the North Royalton Compost Facility may do so beginning on **April 2, 2012 (Monday through Friday), and ending December 8, 2012)**. The facility is located at **10789 Royalton Road at the rear of the property**. If there are any questions regarding the drop-off, call Kurtz Brothers at **440-237-7750**. Proof of residency must be given for residential drop-off.

All non-residents or commercial businesses will be charged on a per cubic yard basis for use of the facility. The facility is operated for North Royalton by Kurtz Brothers.

SUMMARY OF RUBBISH GUIDELINES

Residents are reminded of the following ordinances and policies, which apply for the collection of rubbish.

MATERIALS MUST BE OUT BY 7:00AM of the collection day, but not before sunset of the day prior to the scheduled collection. Route sizes, available equipment and manpower do not allow time for the crews to double back over routes for late put outs. See Holiday Schedule listing for days affected.

1. Containers must have lifting handles, not to exceed 32 gallons capacity nor weigh more than 65 pounds when filled and closed.
2. Plastic bags may be used, but are not to weigh more than 35 pounds when filled and closed.
3. All containers for rubbish must be able to withstand inclement weather. Therefore, cardboard boxes/drums or other cardboard items are not to be used as containers for rubbish. Cardboard boxes are to be flattened, pieces of cardboard tied securely in bundles, large appliance/furniture type boxes are to be cut into two x four foot size and securely tied into bundles. Each bundle cannot weigh more than 65 pounds. (If you wish to recycle cardboard, please see Recycle Guidelines)
4. Magazines placed for trash pick up must be securely tied in bundles not weighing more than 65 pounds per bundle. (If you wish to recycle, please see Recycle Guidelines)
5. Items such as **carpet/padding** must be cut into four-foot wide strips, rolled to no greater than two feet in diameter and tied securely at both ends. The rolls must not weigh more than 65 pounds each.
 - Large items such as furniture, couches and mattresses, etc. are placed for pick up on regular rubbish days.
 - Latex paint cans with only dried or thickened paint (add and stir in kitty litter) will be picked up.
 - White goods pick up for large metal appliances is every Thursday but must be called in to the Service Center prior to Wednesday 4:00PM for scheduling.
 - Curbside recycling collection is every week on the rubbish day. Residents must adhere to the collection requirements as items not meeting guidelines will be tagged and left.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION: Rocks/Earth/Concrete • Liquid and Industrial Waste • Animal Waste • Medical Waste • Hazardous Waste • Flammable Material • Auto Parts / Scrap Metal • Pipe / Fencing • Building Materials

Residents are reminded that it is their responsibility to see that all materials set out for pick up are secured. Crews do not have time to clean up litter, bags or containers that animals or weather scatter about.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION

- **Recyclables (metal, glass, plastic and paper)** are picked up at curbside every week on your regular rubbish day.
- **Yard waste** is collected separately on your regular weekly rubbish day during the scheduled yard waste season from **April 2, 2012 to December 8, 2012**.
- **All materials** for collection must be out by **7:00AM** on collection day but not before sunset of the evening before collection day. **Place all recycle and/or yard waste containers on the opposite side of the drive from rubbish containers.**
- **Waste Collection Days:** Some dates will be affected by **Holidays**. See Holiday Collection Schedule next page.
- **Christmas Tree Collection:** Beginning January 3, 2012 through January 13, 2012.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- **Plastics/Metals/Glass/Paper** – Use only blue recycle bags or blue recycle bins (no larger than 18 gallons). All recycle items may be co-mingled.
- **Paper** – Same as above, paper may also be bundled with cotton cord or twine **ONLY**.
- **Yard Waste** – Use Kraft biodegradable paper bags or 32 gallon containers. **NO** plastic bags, vinyl cord or wire ties for branches.
- **Rinse** all containers.
- **Do not** mix your recyclables with rubbish.

RECYCLING CHART

GLASS (blue bins or recycling bags)	All bottles & jars with caps & rings. Rinse all items.	Window panes, ceramics, mirrors, drinking glasses, light bulbs, etc.
METAL (blue bins or recycling bags)	Aluminum, bi-metal, and steel cans from foods & beverages, aluminum foil and pie/frozen dinner tins. Rinsed and flattened.	Any hazardous waste containers.
PLASTIC BOTTLES (blue bins or recycling bags)	All beverage, milk, water, juice, detergent & bleach bottles with caps & rings. Rinsed & flattened. ALL ITEMS MARKED #1 - #7	Any plastic products not marked #1 - #7
PAPER (blue bins or recycling bags; may be tied w/cotton cord)	Catalogs, newspaper, magazines, cardboard, junk mail, office-computer-school paper & phone books.	Wax, foil or plastic-coated boxes for refrigerator/freezer storage such as frozen food containers, milk cartons & dishwasher detergent boxes.
YARD WASTE (Kraft bags or 32 gal. containers ONLY 4-2-12 to 12-8-12)	Grass clippings, leaves, flowers. Branches (under 8" in diameter) cut to 4' lengths, tied with cotton cord only. Put yard waste containers on opposite side of drive from rubbish.	Do not mix rubbish with yard waste, it will not be picked up. Branches over 8" in diameter. Dirt, rocks or sod. Plastic bags, vinyl cord or wire ties.
WHITE GOODS (picked up on Thursdays) CALL Service Dept 582-3002 to schedule.	Large metal items-washer, dryer, stove, hot water tank, file cabinet, refrigerator, freezer, bikes, etc.	Fuel tanks, propane tanks & metal drums.

NOTE: Bags contaminated with unacceptable items **MUST BE LEFT** by the drivers. Bags must not weigh more than 35 pounds (NR Ord. 1060.04(b)).
