RESOLUTION NO. 12-54

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Stefanik

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMMUNITY MASTER PLANNING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council and the Administration wish to pursue a Community Development Block Grant through the Cuyahoga County Department of Development in the amount of \$30,000 for the purpose of community master planning; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to authorize the Mayor to execute and file an application for Community Development Block Grant funding in the amount of \$30,000 with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development for the purpose of community master planning, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application for Community Development Block Grant funding with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development in the amount of \$30,000 for the purpose of community master planning, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to adopt this legislation in order to meet the application deadline of April 3, 2012.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
