AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
NORTH ROYALTON, PART 2 ADMINISTRATION CODE, CHAPTER 232
DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, SECTION 232.07 PETTY CASH FUNDS,
PARAGRAPH (a)(9), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has determined that it is necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton to provide for an increase in petty cash funds for the Mayor's Court in order to facilitate department operations; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend Section 232.07 of the Codified Ordinances to provide for these funds; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Part 2, Administration Code, Chapter 232 Department of Finance, Section 232.07 Petty Cash Funds, Paragraph (a)(9) which shall hereinafter read as follows:

232.07 PETTY CASH FUNDS.

- (a) Petty cash funds are hereby established as follows:
(9) Mayor's Court ~~\$300.00~~ **\$500.00**

Section 2. Section 232.07, Paragraph (a)(9) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of this Section shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for an increase in petty cash funds for the Mayor's Court in order to facilitate department operations.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
