

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 12-134

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CUYAHOAGA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (CCC) TO PERFORM FIRE-FIGHTING TRAINING EXERCISES FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND CCC STUDENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City is the owner of property located at 14506 State Road, 14466 State Road, and 14436 State Road in the City of North Royalton, Ohio; and

WHEREAS: The City is desirous of destroying and/or demolishing the existing structures in order to redevelop the premises; and

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton wishes to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga Community College District (CCC) permitting CCC to burn and destroy such structures during the course of training exercises for the City Fire Department and CCC students; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga Community College District (CCC) to permit CCC to burn and destroy such structures during the course of training exercises for the City Fire Department and CCC students pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to Cuyahoga Community College District.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga Community College District (CCC) to permit training exercises for the City Fire Department and CCC students.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
