ORDINANCE NO. 14-100

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Stefanik, Marnecheck, Langshaw

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DIGITAL INTEGRATED SYSTEMS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF THE NEW HARDWARE CONFIGURATION AND TRANSITION TO THE NEW CITY HALL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$9,909.40, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Certain communication and IT hardware is to be installed at the current city hall to upgrade existing systems, to allow for the testing of said equipment prior to the move to the newly renovated city hall and to connect other municipal buildings and locations; and

WHEREAS: Upon the occasion of the move to the newly renovated city hall, it will be necessary to remove, relocate and reinstall said hardware in the new facility; and

WHEREAS: The city IT consultant has recommended that Digital Integrated Systems is the proper vendor to complete this task; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement for this service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Digital Integrated Systems for the installation of the new hardware configuration and transition to the new city hall in an amount not to exceed \$9,909.40, pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Digital Integrated Systems for the installation of the new hardware configuration and transition to the new city hall.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
