ORDINANCE NO. 16-65

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DAVID MCNEELEY TO SERVE AS WASTEWATER SUPERINTENDENT FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The position of Wastewater Superintendent is an appointive position; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor has appointed David McNeeley to the position of Wastewater Superintendent; and

WHEREAS: Council confirms the various appointments made by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to confirm this appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby confirms the appointment of David McNeeley to the position of Wastewater Superintendent for the City of North Royalton.

Section 2. Said appointment shall be effective April 25, 2016, and shall run concurrent with the Mayor's term of office, or until such time as a successor has been duly appointed and confirmed.

Section 3. Mr. McNeeley shall receive three (3) weeks paid vacation annually effective upon date of appointment, and shall continue to receive three (3) weeks annually until after year five (5) at which time he shall follow the schedule delineated in the Ordinance establishing various benefits for all full-time non-union employees of the City of North Royalton.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that the position of Wastewater Superintendent is an appointive one and it is immediately necessary to provide for the appointment of this Department Head.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
