

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 17-28

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 15-106 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) PIERCE DASH CF PUC RESCUE PUMPER FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$586,815.34 FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BY INCREASING THE NOT TO EXCEED PRICE BY AN ADDITIONAL \$5,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of a vehicle for the North Royalton Fire Department through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services for an amount not to exceed \$586,815.34 which price included a \$20,000 reduction for the trade in of a rescue pumper and an aerial ladder truck; and

WHEREAS: The aerial ladder truck is no longer available for trade in due to several service issues; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance 15-106 to reflect the exclusion of this trade in vehicle cost and establish a new not to exceed cost of \$591,815.34; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 15-106 is hereby amended to reflect the exclusion of the trade in of an aerial ladder truck in the amount of \$5,000.00 and establish a new not to exceed price of \$591,815.34 as further outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. Ordinance 15-106 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Ordinance 15-106 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 15-106 to reflect the exclusion of the trade in of an aerial ladder truck in the amount of \$5,000.00 and establish a new not to exceed price of \$591,815.34.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
