Thank you for your continued support and participation in our recycling programs. The importance of recycling continues to grow as rubbish disposal costs rise, and all solid waste is disposed at area transfer stations.

Recyclable items have greatly expanded and items may now be co-mingled. Curbside pickup is weekly and should be placed in either blue recycle bags or blue recycle bins only (no larger than 18 gallons).



This recycling brochure is provided so that everyone can participate in the many service programs provided. Please take the time to read and review the recycling guidelines. The guidelines also include information concerning the collection of yard waste and white goods.

North Royalton Recycling Options

North Royalton Curbside Recycling Program

- Rumpke provides curbside recycling service for North Royalton residents.
- The acceptable items on this page should be combined in your blue bag or recycling container. No need to separate.

North Royalton Public Service Dept. Recycling Drop-Off Station (11545 Royalton Road)

- A drop-off recycling station is provided by North Royalton's Dept. of Public Service for North Royalton residents only.
- Combine the following items **unbagged** in the drop-off container. No need to separate.

What to Recycle

These items are accepted in North Royalton's curbside program and at the drop-off station.



Not Accepted for Recycling

Make your efforts worthwhile by not placing these items in your recycling container. They may be dangerous to employees, damage sorting equipment or reduce the success of your program.

Rumpke Service Guidelines

For North Royalton Residents

Rumpke is the service provider for curbside trash and recycling collection for North Royalton residents.

General Service Guidelines

- Residents must supply their own trash bags or cans with handles (no more than 35 gallons and 60 pounds each).
- Place recycling in blue bags or plastic bins (no larger than 18-gallons).
- Place trash and recycling curbside the evening before or by 7 a.m. on your designated service day.

Bulky Items

Rumpke will collect bulky household items on your regular trash day. Please call the North Royalton Service Department at 440-582-3002 at least 24-hours in advance to schedule a bulky item pickup. Examples of a bulky item include an appliance, a carpet roll, a piece of furniture and a large toy. Contact Rumpke for information about items with Freon.

Rumpke Holiday Schedule

Rumpke observes the following holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Independence Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Memorial Day
- Labor Day
- Christmas Day

How do I know if a holiday will delay my service?

- If the holiday is the day-of or a weekday *before* your service day: Service will be delayed one day that week.
- If the holiday is on a weekend or a weekday *after* your service day: Service will remain as scheduled.

Recycling Drop-Off Station

Drop-off stations are available for mixed single stream recycling. Please see page 2 for a list of acceptable recyclables.

Yard Waste Drop-Off Station

Acceptable yard waste items include:

- Grass Clippings & Leaves (must be contained in paper or plastic bags)
- Small Tree & Bush Branches (must be cut to 3 ft. lengths and bundled)

Unacceptable yard waste items include:

- Loose or unbagged materials
- Commercial material or items from businesses
- Strumps or wood from tree removals
- Construction material, dirt, etc.
- Excessive material from large garden or landscaping projects

If you have large amounts of yard waste: Call Royalton Supply at 440-582-5200. Royalton Supply accepts yard waste for a nominal fee. They are located across the street from the North Royalton Service Center.
